This is a free event, and Ted Reinke, who has accompanied many past Savoyards rehearsals, will be at the keys. The event will be held at Oakwood Village West Theatre. Please join us for what will be a heart-warming get-together!

This summer's production is shaping up to be one of our most memorable, as we are collaborating on a G&S double-bill with the Central Midwest Ballet Academy (CMBA). We are pairing the frivolous yet topical *Trial by Jury* 

with Pineapple Poll, a comedic story ballet, accompanied entirely by music from the G&S canon! Pineapple Poll is more commonly performed by concert bands, and this will be the first staged ballet of this piece in the Midwest.

We're excited to announce that we're moving to Madison College's Mitby Theater for two days of performances: August 17 and 18, and tickets are available now. Madison College is handicap accessible, has plenty of free onsite parking, comfortable seating, modern facilities, and room on the stage for the orchestra!

J. Adam Shelton returns as our *Trial by Jury* stage director and we welcome Sergei Pavlov as our musical director. Adam Shelton directed 2018's *Die Fledermaus*, has served on our board of directors

and sung the tenor lead in several of our productions. Sergei Pavlov is new to the Savoyards, but not to the Madison music scene, as he directs the Festival Choir of Madison, and is Assistant Professor of Music at Edgewood College.

## In Rememberance Terry Kiss Frank

We had the distinct pleasure of having Terry Kiss Frank as a Savoyard over the years, starting with her time on the stage in 1984, as Phoebe in *Yeomen of the Guard*, through 2005, as Ruth in *Pirates of Penzance*. During her tenure on the stage she performed all the major G&S alto roles, and most of the minor ones (10 out of the 12!). She was on the board for many years, including president from '85-

'87, and she later transitioned to stage directing for us in the 2000s.

I first worked closely with Terry when she directed our 2006's *Patience*, though in my memory she was a constant presence during the 1990s, when I first started with the Savoyards. Her deep love and enthusiasm for Gilbert and Sullivan were obvious, and so her transition to directing seemed inevitable - and was enthusiastically received.

She was beloved, not only by our company, but by so many around the Madison area. We mourn her passing and are thankful to have known her, to have worked with her, and to have benefited from her bright spirit. Thank you to all who have shared their stories of her with us.
